

**ELDERLY EXEMPTIONS**  
(INCREASE ADOPTED MARCH 11, 2008)

Center Harbor property owners, who are 65 years of age on or before April 1<sup>st</sup> of the year for which the exemption is claimed, and who qualify with the below listed income and asset limits may apply for an **ELDERLY EXEMPTION**. The Elderly Exemption is applied as a reduction in property assessment. In order to qualify, this must be your **Primary Residence** and you must be a **New Hampshire Resident for Five Consecutive Years** preceding April 1<sup>st</sup> in the year the exemption is claimed.
